Hypoplastic Right Heart Syndrome (HRHS) is a range of right-sided congenital heart defects in which the right-sided structures (tricuspid valve, right ventricle and/or pulmonary valve) are underdeveloped or not formed. When these structures are too small or do not function properly, the right side of the heart cannot send enough blood to the lungs.

A more complete repair depends on the size of the pulmonary artery and right ventricle. If the pulmonary artery and right ventricle are very small, the patient may require the same type of operation as other single ventricle patients. In some patients, abnormal channels (sinusoids) form between the coronary

The Normal Right Ventricle The right ventricle pumps the same stroke volume as the left ventricle but with $\approx 25\%$ of the stroke work because of the low resistance of the pulmonary vasculature. Therefore, by virtue of the Laplace relationship, the right ventricle is more thin walled and compliant (Figure 1).

The right ventricle (RV) is the right sided pump of the heart receives deoxygenated blood from the right atrium (RA) via the tricuspid valve and transmits the blood to the lung for oxygenation. Structurally it is characterized by its position, triangular shape, trabeculated nature, with muscular walls thinner than those on the left.
